MAP Testing

From April 23 to May 11, students in grades K through 8 will complete our third and final MAP[®] Growth[™] test from NWEA[®]. We give students MAP Growth tests to determine their instructional level and to measure academic growth throughout the school year (and from year to year) in math, reading, and language in all grade levels. We add MAP science testing in grades 4 through 8. There is no preparation for these assessments besides making sure your child has plenty of rest and a good breakfast throughout the testing period of April 23 to May 11. As in the past, following the testing period, you will receive a report showing your child's growth throughout this school year.
