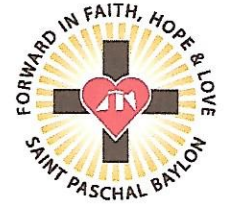

Dear Parent/s and Guardian/s:

We give thanks to all of the families and friends who have sacrificed to provide for our excellent, award-winning Catholic School. We are grateful that you are part of the fabric of this wonderful parish and look forward to more exciting offerings in the year ahead as we unfold our accreditation and parish pastoral plans. Improvements are part of our Paschal Pride!

The faculty, staff and the Finance Council recognize the many sacrifices, dedication and stewardship you live daily. To prepare for next school year, tuition will increase by **3.5%** per student for the coming school year. This increase will provide a reasonable raise for all faculty and staff and the regular health care and other benefit increases that we provide through tuition and fundraising.

In order to secure a spot for your child/children as well as to plan for faculty needs for our next school year, please return the Application/Enrollment Agreement by Friday, February 21 at 2 p.m. along with a **\$225 application fee** per child. If financially unable to meet this registration deadline, please, still let us know that you will be applying. We are happy to make arrangements with you to maintain your place for your student.

The Application & Enrollment Agreement emphasizes the importance of how your participation in fundraising helps to offset the difference between the subsidized costs of your child/children's education and the actual per pupil costs. Through volunteering, fundraising (i.e. Green Knight to Remember Gala, Spring Fling, etc.), supporting our G.I.F.T.S. annual fund appeal and tithing to the church, we work together to provide a hallmark educational experience preparing our students for high school. Please note: our parish raises money for capital expenses, such as the windows, roofs, driveways and parking lots. This is separate from the school's operational budget. We are grateful for those contributions that have already helped this capital project for our driveways and lots. We look forward to completing this million-dollar goal before the bishop gives approval for other improvement projects.

Graduates, as well as high school admissions directors, testify to the great education provided by SPB. Our students consistently graduate with honors, win academic scholarships, and serve our church and world. Thank you for your support and partnership in providing Catholic education for our students.
