**Mission Statement**

**Preschool Philosophy and Goals**

The philosophy and goals of the Saint Paschal Baylon Preschool Program have been developed based on the guidelines provided by the Diocese of Cleveland. The guidelines include that the child should:

1. Become aware of the fact that he/she is a child of God and will grow in His love.
2. Develop a positive self-image and acknowledge his/her self-worth.
3. Develop basic social skills.
4. Increase independence.
5. Develop a trust in adults other than his/her parents.
6. Enjoy being a part of a group and accept the need to share and cooperate.
7. Respect the rights of others and defend his/her own rights.
8. Develop the desire to learn.

Admissions/Age and Type of Program: Admission to the Saint Paschal Baylon Catholic Preschool (3 year old and Pre-Kindergarten program) is open to children who have turned 3, 4, or 5 years old by September 30 of the year of enrollment. Admission to the Junior Kindergarten is open to children who will turn 5 by January 1 the year following enrollment. These students must have at least one year of preschool experience and be screened by our Junior Kindergarten teacher. **All children entering the preschool class must be toilet trained.**

3 Year-Old-\$100.00 **non-refundable** application

Pre-Kindergarten-\$125.00 **non-refundable** application

Junior Kindergarten-\$150.00 **non-refundable** application

Admission Priority: Children will be considered for admission to Saint Paschal Baylon Preschool based on the following priorities:

1. **Siblings:** Children who have siblings currently enrolled in the preschool or day school.
2. **Parishioners:** Children of families who are registered and supporting parishioners of Saint Paschal Baylon parish as determined by the Rectory (Application date, regular contributions.)
3. **Non-Parishioners:** Children will be admitted on a first-come, first-served basis, depending on the available space in the program of your child's age level.

Transportation: Parents/Guardians must provide transportation. No bus transportation is available.

Uniforms: None required; children should wear appropriate comfortable clothing.

Also included will be an important packet of forms which must be returned at the Parent/Guardian Meeting, held before the start of school in late summer. ***Please be aware that if these materials are not received before the first regular day of preschool, the student will not be permitted to attend until the forms are submitted.***
