### **PHILOSOPHY AND GOALS**

The philosophy and goals of our kindergarten program are in accordance with the philosophy and goals of Saint Paschal Baylon Catholic School and the Cleveland Catholic Diocese.

Our program encourages growth in physical, intellectual, social, emotional and spiritual development. It is designed to provide a creative learning environment for the young child and an opportunity for association with other children through play and learning activities.

Saint Paschal Baylon is committed to:

- a warm, affirming environment
- religious formation
- the creativity and structure that nurture cognitive, social and language development
- compliance with the educational norms set by the State of Ohio
- development of the skills each child needs to confidently enter subsequent grade levels.

Entrance Age: Your child must be five years old on or before August 1, 2021.

School Policies: Kindergarten policies are the same as grades one through eight. Parents will receive a Parent Kindergarten Guide and should access our School Handbook on our website before the start of school.

Programs Available: Saint Paschal Baylon offers a full-day program. The program is from 8:05 AM to 2:30 PM.

Transportation: Transportation for our kindergarten pupils is provided only by the following public school districts: Mayfield, Richmond Heights, Willoughby/Eastlake, and South Euclid/Lyndhurst. Saint Paschal Baylon Catholic School will provide the necessary information to the transportation office of each district.

Uniforms: The kindergarten students are required to wear a uniform. School uniforms can be purchased through Schoolbelles.

Kindergarten Teachers: Mrs. Dani Alan and Ms. Evamarie Mickol. The teacher aide is Mrs. Teri Valentino.

Immunizations: All children entering kindergarten must meet the following requirements:

- four immunizations against DPT
- a series of three hepatitis B vaccine
- three immunizations against polio
- two MMRs. Measles, mumps and rubella must have been given on or after your child's first birthday and the second dose at least 28 days after first dose.
- two doses of Varicella

Fees and Tuition: The non-refundable education fee is \$225.00. Tuition 2021-2022 is \$4,900.00 (parishioner) and \$6,575.00 (non-parishioner). Tuition can be paid yearly or by semester, or monthly/quarterly through the FACTS Program. Ed Choice vouchers are not accepted at this time.

Application Period: Opens on January 1, 2021. Please submit ONLINE:

- birth certificate
- baptismal certificate
- any court order or shared parenting agreement
- **non-refundable** education fee of \$225.00 payable to Saint Paschal Baylon Catholic School.

Acceptance: Kindergarten Screening for all children who have applied will be held in the spring. You will be notified of the dates and will be asked to bring your child for this short series of kindergarten readiness examinations. You will be notified by mail of acceptance into our kindergarten program. Enrollment materials will be mailed to you at this time.

Extended Day Program: Saint Paschal Baylon Extended Day Program provides after school care from 2:30 PM until 6:00 PM. The program is available on scheduled school days only. Registration information may be obtained from the school office.
