- We completed the filming of our marketing video. We are so excited to share it with everyone.
- Our 7th and 8th grade brain brawl team competed at St. Ignatius High School on October 9th. They placed third among 24 teams.
- Our sports teams had an amazing fall season. Our 7-8 grade girls soccer team lost in the CYO City Championship and our 8th grade girls volleyball team placed second in the Elite Tier. Our 8th grade boys lost in the championship as well.
- Our revamped Green Knight program began November 1st. Students have been introduced to it last week over broadcast. The anchors reminded us of the 4 C's (Civility, Courage, Character, and Compassion) and all centered in Christ.
- We brought back Mr. Mack from McKeon Education Group to present two social-emotional programs with our students. Third grade is doing "Fostering Friendships" and Fourth Grade is doing "Connections". This has been paid through a grant we wrote and were granted through the Ohio Catholic Federal Credit Union as well as Title IV funds. We are hoping to find some funding to do " Honor and Harmony" in 5th grade later this year.
- ALICE training with Sgt. McGrath finished up. All classes from preschool through grade 8 have completed the training and our faculty was retrained as well.
- We finalized the focus of our We Give Catholic campaign which is November 30th. We have decided to focus our efforts on raising money for Active Panels. We have secured matching donors who are willing to match funds raised totaling just over 16,000!!
- Thank you for all the amazing work the PTO did with the Walkathon. It was such a fun and fantastic event!!
